# General information on accommodation

## Academic year 2019-2020

Locations Eindhoven and Tilburg

Fontys University does not have its own accommodation, but acts as a mediator between the student and the housing agency / landlord. At Fontys the Student Administration International is in charge of the organization of accommodation for international students.

## 1. Standard accommodation (student room)

- The room measures at least 10 m2 (in case the room measures smaller, usually a shared living room is available or a lower rent is calculated).
- The room will be furnished and contains at least a bed (including duvet, pillow and 1 set of bed linen), cupboard, desk and chair.
- Shared facilities are at least a kitchen with kitchen utensils, shower/bathroom, toilet, laundry machine and access to internet (not always wireless). Sometimes extra costs for use of laundry machine and/or set of bed linen are charged.
- Distance to the Fontys campus is maximum 30 minutes by bicycle.
- Rooms in Fontys cities and therefore rental prices differ significantly. It is not possible to select a specific housing agency, room and/or rental fee.
- The rent is according the local market value in a range of € 325 € 450 per month, energy and internet costs included.
- It is prohibited to live in a single room with more than one person.

### ATTENTION limited available:

- Fontys University has the opportunity to offer some more private rooms.
- They are small studio's with a bedroom and private shower and toilet.
- Use of shared kitchen.
- The amount of rent will be at most €600,00 per month, energy and internet costs included. If you are interested, you can indicate this on your accommodation form. Please note that it is not guaranteed you will have one, because there are only a limited number of these studio's available.

## 2. Costs and payments

- Different types of costs will be charged. Usually the student is requested to make a pre-payment of the following to the housing agency/landlord before arrival:
  - the first + last month of rent
  - cleaning costs (max. € 100)
  - refundable deposit (for coverage of damage)
  - administration fee
- It goes without saying that the student is responsible for keeping the accommodation and shared facilities intact, tidy and clean.
- When the use of energy is significantly more than average, the student will probably have to pay extra. So use energy wisely!
- The student is responsible for paying the monthly rent (in time), so before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the upcoming month. This is not the responsibility of Fontys.

### 3. Rental period

- In principal a Bachelor student applies for a rental period of one full study year. An Exchange student applies for a rental period of one semester, sometimes 2 semesters.
- After the final date of a rental contract, the student should find a new room at a legal address by himself/herself!

## 4. Further conditions:

- Arriving later or leaving earlier than the mentioned period on the accommodation form will not lead to a lower total amount of rent.
- Ending the contract earlier than the agreed upon rental period, will only be possible in exceptional cases and only with the approval of the housing agency / landlord and Fontys.

## 5. Comments or complaints

In case of comments or complaints about the accommodation, the student should contact the housing agency / landlord, as the rental contract is closed between student and housing agency/ landlord.
