Language requirements	Exchange students are expected to have a good command of English. For all students we expect a statement from the university on the student's level of English (the minimum is B2, IELTS (6.0), TOEFL iBT (80), TOEFL PBT (550) or similar certificate).

Admission Requirements	After the application documents in Mobility Online have been approved, Fontys will issue an acceptance letter. Students will receive more information about their enrolment and the start of the programme after admission.

Accommodation	Fontys can arrange accommodation for exchange students. To apply for accommodation assistance through Fontys, students need to fill out an accommodation form before the application deadline in Mobility Online. Please keep in mind that we can't guarantee we have sufficient rooms on offer, this due to a national shortage in student accommodation.
Insurance	<p>By law everyone in The Netherlands must be insured for medical expenses. The third party liability insurance and repatriation insurance are strongly recommended. Every student enrolled at Fontys is expected to have fulfilled his/her insurance obligations before arriving. Fontys cannot be held liable if a student does not have (sufficient) insurance cover. Visa and/or residence permit	Students may not apply for their own entry visa and/or residence permit. Fontys has an agreement with the Dutch Immigration Service (the 'IND') and will therefore, as part of the application procedure, apply for entry visas and residence permits on behalf of its students (if applicable). The student will receive a payment letter for the visa costs. Besides this, the IND requires financial proof of living expenses before students start their studies. The student can prove this amount through bank statements but the money can also be transferred to the Fontys bank account. Both possibilities will be given to the student during the visa application procedure. More information: www.fontys.edu
Financial matters	The average living expenses per month for a foreign student in Holland are between € 900 and € 1,200 per month. These living expenses cover rent, insurance, food, public transportation, books, clothing and other general costs.
