

FLOWCHART MINOR STUDY ABROAD FALL 2022: WHAT TO EXPECT

I am registered for a minor Study Abroad.

International travel is highly affected by the corona crisis. When planning your minor Study Abroad you will have to consider at least the following uncertainties and risks:

In general, you can expect one of the following scenarios

A Your host university will offer **on-campus or blended** (online and offline) classes. The travel code for your country of destination is **green** or **yellow** on the day of departure.

Please note that the travel advice may change just before or on the day of your departure/arrival. The travel code of the time you enter the country of your destination is leading.

You are allowed to travel to your host university to attend the semester.

Please be aware that the travel code may change during your time abroad. If the travel code changes to orange or red Fortis will strongly advise you to come back to the Netherlands or your home country.

Make sure to:

1. have a thorough look at your (travel) insurance
2. keep your contact details up-to-date in Mobility Online at all times and have close contact with your coordinator Internationalisation
3. have a filled-out risk analysis

1. Partner universities may decide to cancel their on-campus classes/exchange semester. This can happen in the next few weeks, shortly before your departure or during your time abroad.
2. The travel advice from the Dutch ministry of Foreign Affairs is leading, code orange or red = you will not be allowed to travel. Travel codes can vary per region and may change suddenly.
3. Preparing your minor Study Abroad will likely come with required payments at some point (tickets, accommodation, visa etc.). Please be aware that all financial risks are for the student.
4. The corona crisis continues to have a big impact on day-to-day life. Your experience abroad may be very different from what you were expecting.
5. The unpredictability of the corona crisis could cause a study delay.

B Your host university will offer **on-campus or blended** (online and offline) classes. The travel code for your country of destination is **orange** or **red** on the day of departure.

You are not allowed to travel to your host university.

Plan B, please inform your coordinator Internationalisation or Team Study Abroad about your cancellation.

C Your host university cancels the (on-campus) exchange semester.

If applicable, take your minor Study Abroad online with your partner university.

or

Plan B, please inform your coordinator Internationalisation or Team Study Abroad about your cancellation.

D You wish to cancel your minor Study Abroad (e.g. because of the high level of uncertainty).

Plan B, please inform your coordinator Internationalisation or Team Study Abroad about your cancellation.
