No one likes to have health concerns, especially not in a foreign country. But if this happens the medical professionals of SGE International are there to support you. You are welcome to register at the health care center for internationals: SGE International at Stijp -S in Eindhoven.

THE DUTCH MEDICAL SYSTEM

If you need a doctor, you can call to make an appointment to consult a general practitioner (in Dutch 'huisarts'), and through your general practitioner you will have access to all the services of the Dutch medical system. General practitioners give consultations throughout the day.

EMERGENCIES

During office hours (8:00 am - 5:00 pm): contact your general practitioner on T. 040- 711 67 30. Outside office hours (5:00 pm - 8:00 am and weekends): you can call the general practitioner on duty at the central doctor's practice (Huisartsenpost) on T. 0900-8861.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Every person that lives or works in the Netherlands has the obligation to take out a Dutch Health Insurance policy (Basisverzekering), although there are a few exceptions. Ask your employer about your status or check our website for details.


